# Our work with you

Northside Partnership work together with individuals, groups, families and businesses to bring about positive change in people's lives and communities in north east Dublin. To provide our services we need to get to know you and gather some information about your current circumstances. When you join with us we will commit to work together in a way that values your skills, capabilities and goals.

# Why we collect your information

- To make sure you are eligible for the service and that we are the right service for you to meet your goals
- To make a plan and to understand your goals/aspirations and challenges
- To track the steps we have both taken to meet the goals in the plan
- Work with you in creating a progression plan and track the activities to completion
- To research 'what works well' which helps improve our services to better meet what the community sees as important.

# Why this agreement is necessary

- To set out the details of the information that we collect, how we process it and who we share it with.
- To explain your rights under data protection law in relation to our processing of your data.
- To acquire your consent/agreement in order to process your personal data (which may include some sensitive data regarding your background and current circumstances).

## Your Information and how we process it

- The personal data we collect will only be provided by you.
- We store your information on paper forms and on various databases. Paper records are locked in filing cabinets when not in use and our databases are secured using the latest technology available in accordance with the Data Protection Law.
- Our policy operates on the principle that we keep your personal data for no longer than is necessary only for the purpose for which we collected it. It is also kept in accordance with any contract obligations that our funders requires us to apply.
- We may share your data with other service providers (*e.g. contacting a potential employer or making an appointment with another service*). This will only be done with your prior agreement

# Your Rights

Under the Data Protection Law you have the right to withdraw from this agreement and/or request a copy of your information at any time. You can also have your information amended and your file permanently deleted.

\*\*Note: the right of children to be protected from harm overrides all considerations of confidentiality in line with the Childcare Act, 1991
